# Resource Development/Delineation

- Multiple Oil and Gas Accumulations
- Limited Area Proposed for Development
- Development Proposal for the oil resources proposed to be exploited is reasonable
- Need to acquire information to fully assess resources not proposed for development
- A plan to fully assess all resources not proposed for development should be put in place
- Goal to maximize oil and gas recovery in the area

# Facilities

- GBS is the best option to maximize oil and gas recovery
- Facilities should provide for additional production/development (ie. J-tubes, well slots)
- Water and gas processing facilities is also key and appear to be reasonable for the proposed development
- Maintenance program needs to accommodate full resource exploitation cycle

# Access to Infrastructure

- Need to provide access for potential resource development by operators outside development area
- Commercial issues- should not be a profit center
- Industry/government should develop code of practice

# Commercial Arrangements

- Currently only SDLs 1006, 1007, 1009 and 1010 included in the development area
- Commercial arrangements should provide for all Hebron and Ben Nevis significant discovery licences
- Commercial issues should be resolved early so as not to impede resource development

# Gas Conservation

- Limited gas supplies, will be largely required for fuel
- Gas flaring needs to be managed
- Technology to reduce gas flaring should be considered



# Environment

- Spills and Authorized Discharges
- Gas Flaring and Produced Water
- Produced Water Reinjection
- Fisherpersion Training in Oil Spill Response

# Benefits

- Hebron will help sustain oil development and provide opportunity to exploit other oil and gas resources
- Will provide opportunity to further advance NL business , Research and Development, and Education and Training
- Opportunity to make substantial progress on women participation in the work force

# Safety

- Oil industry has made a substantial contribution to NL safety culture
- We have been reactive
- Need to engage worker representatives in development of safety legislation
